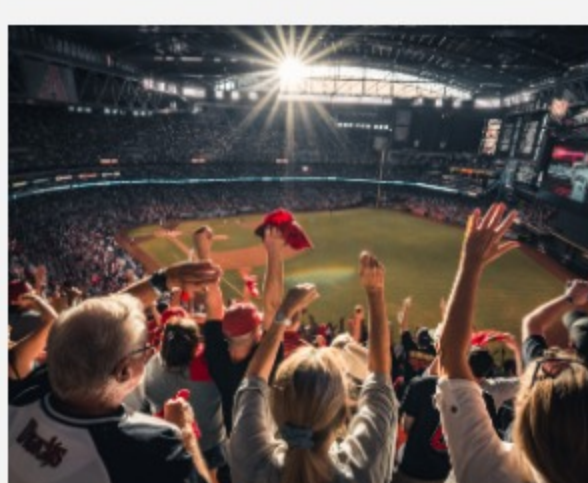

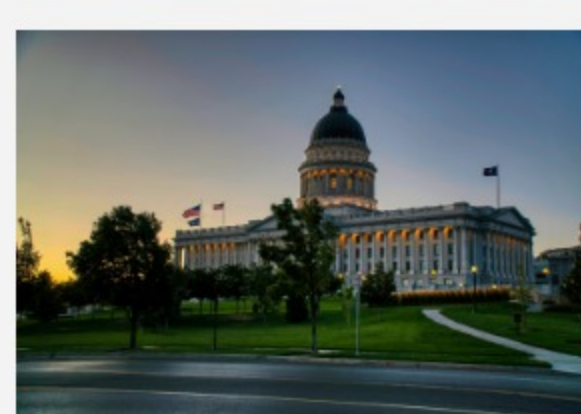


Larry H. & Gail Miller Family Foundation Pledges \$22 Million to Salt Lake City's Ballpark NEXT Fund

A bill introduced in the Utah State Legislature would sell the 312-acre campus the state hospital sits on for development, with the money earmarked for better mental health services.

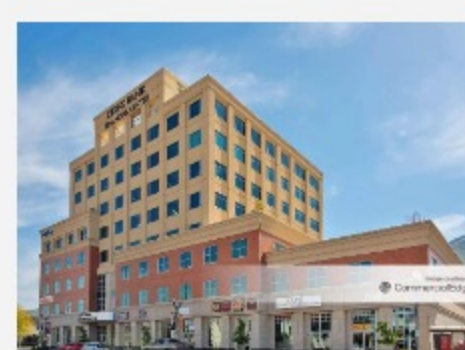


Why are master-planned communities taking Utah by storm?

A health and wellness brand will relocate its offices to downtown Provo.



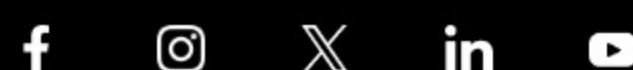
